


## Guide to free parental access to Ebooks on the Oxford Owl website.


These resources support the reading material that we regularly use in school. There will be many familiar characters and settings.




Activate the email link that they send to you.


Go onto the parents' area of the oxford owl website and select ebooks.



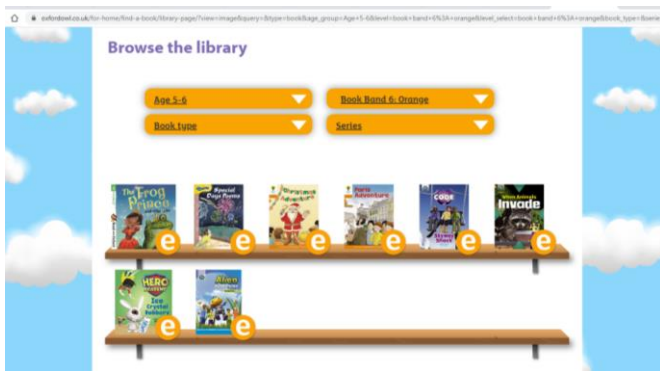
When you have done this, choose your child's age.



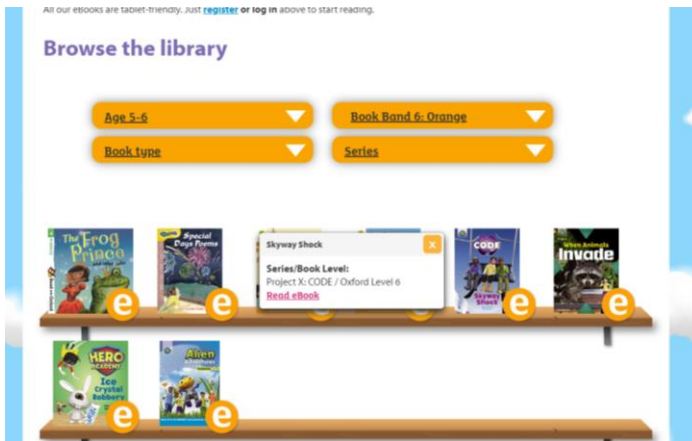
Then in the levels section, choose their book band.
