EYFS (Nursery and Reception) News

Reception News:

Wow, what a great first week we've all had in reception! All the children are settling in fantastically and it's lovely to see so many smiling faces! It's been great getting to know everyone's names and their interests too! This week we've spent lots of time learning routines and also where things belong in our classrooms. Some of the things we have enjoyed exploring this week are playdough, water play, painting and reading books.

Family photos: We would like each child to bring in a photo of their family for us to have at school. Initially, your child will have the opportunity to discuss their family with us and then the family photo will be displayed in our classroom.

How can you help at home?

- -Talk positively about school (I wonder what you did at school today...)
- -Share stories
- -Practise together recognising and writing your child's name using their name card in their reading wallet.

Friday Forest Fun is starting Friday 16th September.

During the first part of the Autumn term your child will be participating in 6 weekly Forest Fun sessions. The sessions will take place on a Friday afternoon in the forest area at Pool Meadow, Stottesdon run by our trained Early Years Team. A natural woodland area the Muggleton, Datlen, Datlen-Gough families have kindly volunteered for the school to enhance our outdoor learning opportunities.

During our Friday Forest Fun sessions, children will learn about the natural environment from first hand experiences. Children will explore, play, and learn using a range of activities (both designed by the leader and chosen by the children themselves). Activities will include den-building, learning knots, creative making, using natural materials such as clay and willow, tool skills and cooking on a campfire. These activities develop a sense of independence, problem-solving skills, social skills, and teamwork which are important life skills for our children.

A voluntary contribution of £2.50 per session (£15.00 for 6 weeks) will cover resources to support our outdoor learning, hot chocolate, and marshmallows, along with extra staffing to support lower ratios.


Squid


