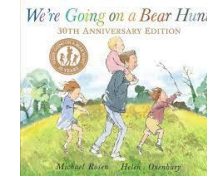
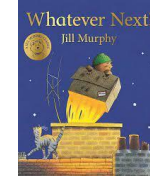

As writers we will be continuing to ascribe meaning to our marks. Learning letter formation rhymes to support our name writing.

As mathematicians we will be learning to talk about and identify the patterns around us. For example: stripes on clothes, designs on rugs and wallpaper. Use informal language like 'pointy', 'spotty', 'blobs'. We will be extending and creating ABAB patterns - stick, leaf, stick, leaf.



As explorers we will be learning about space, where and how we can travel on holiday and what's in our community around our nursery.

In PE we will practicing ball skills; throwing, kicking and catching.

As artists we will be exploring what happens when we mix two colours together, in music we will be responding to what they have heard, expressing their thoughts and feelings.
