Think about how they look and sound (adjectives), and how they move (how adverbs and verbs). Tuesday - Look at the letter that Mr Grinling has written to the Seagulls asking them to stop. (sent via email from school). Identify the features of a letter (resources emailed from school). Wednesday - Role play activities about being a seagull looking for sandwiches. Thursday and Friday - Is a different activity to write your own school report.</p>

<p><u>Geography</u></p>  <p>Purple Mash email sent Tuesday.</p>	<p>We are going to focus on human (man made) geography this week. Try this online lesson about cities, towns and villages. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/articles/zy2hqfr</p>
<p><u>History</u></p>  <p>Purple mash email sent Wednesday.</p>	<p>We are going to find out about the people who live in Australia. Ask an adult to share the presentation from the Royal Geographical Society about "Who are the Australian people with you?". This will be emailed to you on purple mash and also will be saved in the home learning folder on purple mash. Discuss with them what you have found out. Listen to the Australian National Anthem.</p>
<p><u>IT</u></p> <p>Purple mash email sent Thursday.</p>	<p>This week, we are going to begin to learn how to touch type. Touch typing is when we learn to type using fingers that reach the different keys easily. We are going to start with the "home" keys. They are the middle row of keys. Look at the posters, which will be attached to your purple mash email and saved in the home learning work on purple mash to find out more about the home keys. Then try the Purple Mash typing 2dos for the home keys.</p>
