

5 Times Tables

$1 \times 5 = 5$	$0 \times 5 = 0$
$3 \times 5 = 15$	$2 \times 5 = 10$
$5 \times 5 = 25$	$4 \times 5 = 20$
$7 \times 5 = 35$	$6 \times 5 = 30$
$9 \times 5 = 45$	$8 \times 5 = 40$
$11 \times 5 = 55$	$10 \times 5 = 50$
	$12 \times 5 = 60$

Top tips

1. All multiples of 5 end in a 5 or a 0.
2. If you multiply an odd number by 5, the ones digit will be a 5.
3. If you multiply an even number by 5, the ones digit will be a 0.
4. 5 is half of 10, so you could multiply a number by ten and halve it.
