- 3. Some are easy answers you know already.  $0 \times 4$ ,  $10 \times 4$ ,  $2 \times 4$ ,  $5 \times 4$ ,  $11 \times 4$ .
- 4. The pattern in the ones is 0, 4, 8, 2, 0, 4, 8, 2
- 5. The pattern in the tens is 1, 1, 2, 2, 2, 3, 3, 4, 4, 4
